BACKGROUND: Adoption of Resolution No. 2004-014 appoints the Director of the Transportation Department as the Engineer to prepare a Report regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 31 into Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LM District No. 89-1-C).

Resolution No. 2004-015 declares the Board's intention of ordering the annexation of Zone 31 into L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C. Annexation of Zone 31 into L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C will fund the maintenance and servicing of landscaping improvements within public right-of-ways located northerly of Acacia Ave. in the Hemet area and includes 20 single-family residential lots.

The proposed budget of fiscal year 2004-2005 for Zone 31 is \$5,000.00 that will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2004-2005 within Zone 31 of \$250.00 per parcel. The annual assessment will be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the CPI-U, if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2004.

Consistent with the Board's direction regarding compliance with Article XIID of the California Constitution and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the attached resolutions have been prepared and a public hearing scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on March 2, 2004 to receive testimony for and against the proposed assessment. Each property owner within the proposed Zone 31 will receive a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2004-015 and an information sheet.

All ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. If, at the time designated for the tabulation of the ballots, the ballots submitted in favor of the annexation and levy of the assessment exceed the ballots submitted in opposition of the annexation and levy of the assessment in Zone 31, Zone 31 will be annexed into L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C.

3 **RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE**
4 **ANNEXATION OF ZONE 31 INTO LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT**
5 **NO. 89-1- CONSOLIDATED OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE PURSUANT TO**
6 **THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972 AND ORDERING PREPARATION**
7 **OF ENGINEER'S REPORT REGARDING SAID ANNEXATION**

8 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the Board of Supervisors”) of the County of
9 Riverside (hereinafter the “County”) has been advised by the Transportation Department (hereinafter
10 “Department”) of the County that said Department has received a request from the owners of property
11 in the unincorporated area of the County (hereinafter “Zone 31”), as shown and described in Exhibit “A”,
12 which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, to be annexed into Landscaping and Lighting
13 Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (hereinafter “L&LMD No. 89-1-C”) of the County of
14 Riverside, State of California, and the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is necessary and
15 desirable to initiate proceedings for the annexation of Zone 31 into L&LMD No. 89-1-C pursuant to the
16 Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of Division 15 of
17 Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter, respectively, the “Act” and the “Street and Highways Code”);
18 and

19 WHEREAS, such proceedings shall comply with the requirements of Articles XIID of the
20 California Constitution, requiring voter approval of the proposed assessment to be levied by L&LMD
21 No. 89-1-C for Zone 31; and

22 WHEREAS, the Director of the Transportation Department, or his designee, is a licensed and
23 registered civil engineer, has expertise with respect to the annexation of territory to landscaping and
24 lighting maintenance districts and the levying of assessments for said purpose and, therefore, is able to
25 serve as the engineer (hereinafter the “Engineer”) for the County with regard to the annexation of Zone
26 31 into L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the
2 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session on January 13, 2004 as
3 follows:

4 Section 1. Recitals. The Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines that all the
5 above recitals are true and correct.

6 Section 2. Annexation. The Board of Supervisors proposes to annex Zone 31 into L&LMD
7 No. 89-1-C and to initiate and conduct proceedings therefore pursuant to the Act for the purpose of
8 levying an annual assessment on all parcels within Zone 31 to pay the costs of the following services
9 and improvements:

10 (a) The maintenance and servicing of landscaping within the public right-of-way,
11 including the trimming, fertilizing, weeding and replanting of trees, shrubs, grass, other ornamental
12 vegetation; and,

13 (b) The maintenance and servicing of irrigation facilities.

14 Section 3. Boundaries and Designation. The boundaries of Zone 31 that is proposed to be
15 annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C shall include all of the property as shown and described in Exhibit "A".

16 Section 4. Report. The Director of the Transportation Department of the County, or his
17 designee, is hereby designated Engineer and is ordered to prepare and file a report with the Clerk of
18 the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Sections 22608 and 22585 et. seq. of the Streets and
19 Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIID of the California Constitution regarding said annexation
20 and the levy.

21 Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of
22 adoption.

EXHIBIT "A"

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES

The boundaries of Zone 31 proposed to be annexed into Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated, of the County of Riverside are coterminous with the boundaries of Lots 1-20 of Tract Map No. 26327, in the County of Riverside, State of California as shown on Map recorded in Map Book 340, Pages 81-82, inclusive, all Records of the Recorder, Riverside County, California.

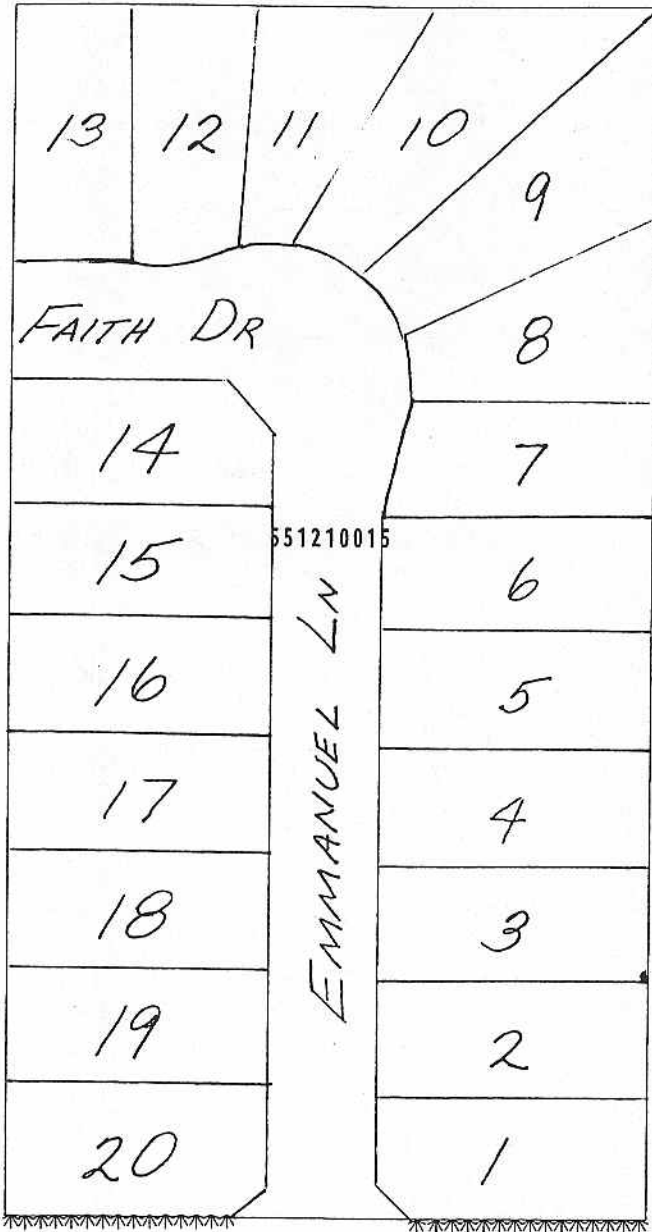
