SUBJECT: Second Amendment to the Consulting Services Agreement for the SR-60 Landscaping and Scenic Beautification Project.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the attached second amendment to the Consulting Services Agreement between the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside ("Agency") and V2C Group, Inc. to provide additional landscaping architectural design services in the amount of \$86,520 for the SR-60 Landscaping and Scenic Beautification Project ("Project").

Departmental Concurrence

BACKGROUND: On November 19, 1999, the Redevelopment Agency and the Transportation Department submitted a joint application to the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) for funding from the Federal Transportation Enhancement Activities Program for the Jurupa Valley Interchange Landscaping and Beautification Project. On January 12, 2002, the RCTC approved the project for funding in the amount of \$1,595,000 for construction. The grant requires that the Agency fund the design of the improvements which will beautify six-interchanges along the 60 freeway at Van Buren Boulevard, Etiwanda Avenue, Country Village Road, Pedley Road, Pyrite Street, and Rubidoux Boulevard in unincorporated Riverside County.

(Background Continued)

On April 18, 2000, the Board approved an agreement with V2C Group, Inc. to prepare plans and specifications for the SR 60 Landscaping and Scenic Beautification Project. On November 26, 2002, the Board approved the first amendment to the original agreement in the amount of \$69,950. During the course of final design, the scope and design requirements of the project were revised to reflect the most recent changes requested by Caltrans. The most recent changes will require additional architectural and engineering services which include coordination and preparation of the CalTrans Local Assistance obligation package for Federal Transportation Enhancement Activities Program funding, additional digital file conversions from AutoCAD to Microstation; additional irrigation design; attendance of weekly Project Design Team Meetings; revisions to existing landscape plans; rewriting of specifications and research and coordination of additional traffic control engineering and planning.

These additional landscape design and engineering services are necessary to complete the project and will benefit the Jurupa Valley Redevelopment Project Area ("Project Area"), by improving the overall appearance of the Project Area and SR60 on and off-ramps, which are currently devoid of any significant landscaping. Agency staff recommends that the Board of Directors approve the second amendment to the contract for these additional services.
