7 pursuant to Section 18 of the District Act giving notice of its intention to construct a project in
8 Zone 6, northwesterly of the city of Desert Hot Springs, designated as the Mission Lakes Levee
9 and giving further notice that the project would be considered at a public hearing on January 27,
10 2004; and

11 WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was properly made by publication and
12 posting as required by law, and all persons desiring to be heard on the matter were given the
13 opportunity to appear and present testimony, both oral and written; and

14 WHEREAS, all requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act and the
15 District Rules to Implement the Act have been met and the General Manager-Chief Engineer of
16 the District has found that the project will not have a significant adverse effect upon the
17 environment and has completed a Mitigated Negative Declaration; now, therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
19 Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular
20 session assembled on January 27, 2004 based upon the evidence and testimony presented on the
21 matter, both written and oral, that:

ENGINEER'S STATEMENT

**Mission Lakes Levee
Project No. 6-8-0075
September 2003**

The Mission Lakes Levee project consists of the replacement and rehabilitation and the subsequent operation and maintenance of a levee approximately 5,800 linear feet in length. The project is located within unincorporated Riverside County northwesterly of the city of Desert Hot Springs, and is generally bounded by the Little San Bernardino mountains on the north, Mission Lakes Boulevard on the south, Indian Avenue on the west, and the Mission Lakes County Club development on the east.

The purpose of the proposed project is to provide 100-year flood protection to the existing Mission Lakes Country Club development. The estimated cost of the project is approximately \$1.4 million. Construction and future operation and maintenance costs will be borne by the District's Zone 6 revenue.
