**BACKGROUND:** The City of Banning has expressed a desire to contract with the Department of Environmental Health to provide Vector Control Services within the City's jurisdiction. These services include plague surveillance, mosquito surveillance, fly and mosquito control, rodent and cockroach control, advice and assistance, community awareness and abatement projects, complaint response, public presentations, consultations, public education with flyers and booklets, and enforcing adopted Riverside County Ordinances 523 and 527.

Similar contracts for our Department to provide vector control services currently exists for the incorporated cities of Beaumont, Canyon Lake, Hemet, Moreno Valley, Murrieta and Temecula. The services provided are typically minimal and normally do not exceed \$3,000 per year in total cost.

This Agreement has an effective date of July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004. Thereafter, the Agreement shall continue from month to month until terminated upon 30 (thirty) days written notice given by either party to the other.

**FINANCIAL:**

The City of Banning will be billed for all services requested on an hourly basis which includes the Department's cost for salaries, benefits, supplies and support. There will be no cost to the County for providing these services.
