

BACKGROUND:

As a result of RFP#PUARC104, Cameron Hill Aftercare Services, Inc. was awarded a contract for \$471,931 to provide Independent Living Skills Program Aftercare Services. The Board of Supervisors approved this contract on April 22, 2003 under Agenda Item #3.14. The Aftercare component of Independent Living Skills Program provides support and guidance to former foster youth as they transition out of the foster care system into adulthood. The core purpose of Cameron Hill's ILSP aftercare program is to provide career development and career counseling services through the implementation of transitional individualized case management plans with time limited specific goals and services geared towards self-sufficiency. These services include referrals to community resources, educational and employment services, assistance with temporary shelter, outreach plans, special events, and administering and disbursing cash grants and subsidies.

Since April of this year, DPSS has referred over 400 youth to this program. Due to the overwhelming demand and need for these services, it was determined that additional funding was needed to increase the level of services available to these youth. This amendment, which equates to approximately \$375 per youth, will allow Cameron Hill to provide a wider range self-sufficiency services in crucial areas such as training, housing assistance, transportation needs, and vocational/school related assistance.
