SUBJECT: Resolution 413-552 establishing No-Parking Zones on Almond Street and on Canyon Drive, Wildomar area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-552 to establish No-Parking Zones between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. on school days on Almond Street and on Canyon Drive in the Wildomar area, as described in attached Resolution 413-552. Also that the Board repeal existing Ordinance No. 413.17 for a No-Parking Zone on the south side of Canyon Drive.


BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department was contacted by residents in the Wildomar area in regard to no-parking zones on Almond Street and on Canyon Drive near Elsinore High School. High school students are using Almond Street and Canyon Drive for parking during school hours. There are residences on both Almond Street and Canyon Drive with driveway access and curbside mailboxes blocked by parked vehicles.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and determined that the proposed No-Parking Zones on Almond Street and Canyon Drive will improve traffic operation and safety along these roadways. There is an existing Elsinore High School student parking lot which was recently constructed on the corner of Canyon Drive and Orchard Street that has enough empty parking spaces to accommodate the vehicles currently parked on Almond Street and Canyon Drive. We have contacted the affected property owners and Elsinore High School staff, and sent letters to affected property owners on Canyon Drive and Almond Street. As of February 6, we have not received any objections from affected property owners regarding the proposed No-Parking Zones.

Ordinance No. 413.17 is for an existing No-Parking Zone on the south side of Canyon Drive opposite to the school. For administrative purposes, it is hereby repealed. The proposed resolution includes this existing No-Parking Zone and additional parking prohibitions on Canyon Drive.

5 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
6 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on
7 February 24, 2004, that pursuant to Ordinance No. 413, the following No-
8 Parking Zones are hereby established in the Wildomar area:

10 On the east and west sides of Almond Street starting at a point 30 feet south of
11 the centerline of Canyon Drive to a point 30 feet north of the centerline of
12 Walnut Street, a total distance of approximately 1,270 feet.

13
14 On the south side of Canyon Drive starting at a point 30 feet west of the
15 centerline of Orange Street to a point 30 feet east of the centerline of Orchard
16 Street, a total distance of approximately 2,580.

17
18 On the north side of Canyon Drive starting at a point 190 feet west of the
19 centerline of Orange Street to a point 610 feet west of the centerline of Orange
20 Street, a total distance of approximately 420 feet.

23 These no-parking zones shall be in effect between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. on
24 school days.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that
2 Ordinance No. 413.17, heretofore adopted by this Board of Supervisors on February 14,
3 1978, is hereby repealed.

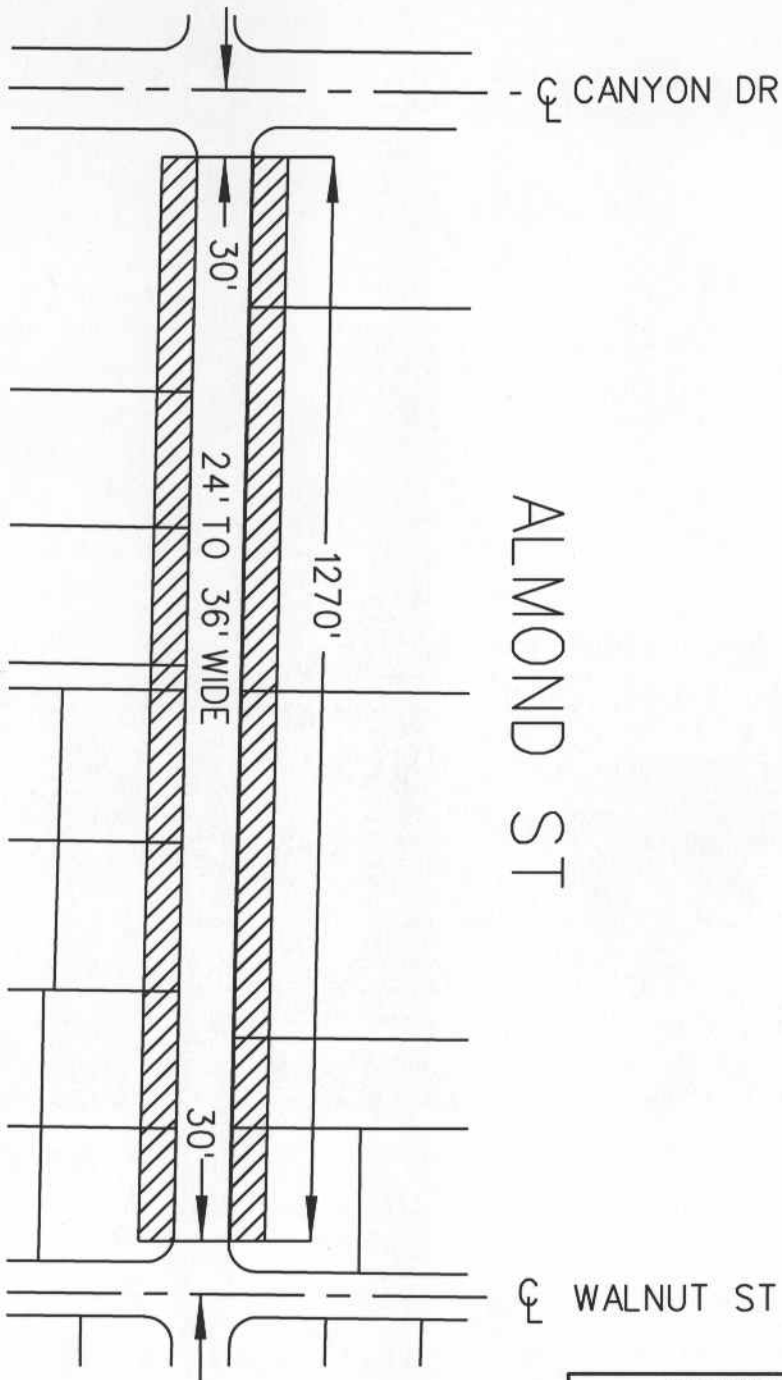

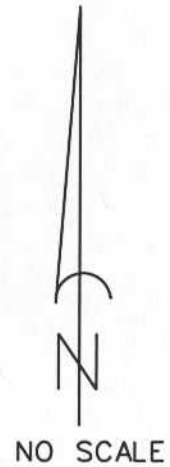

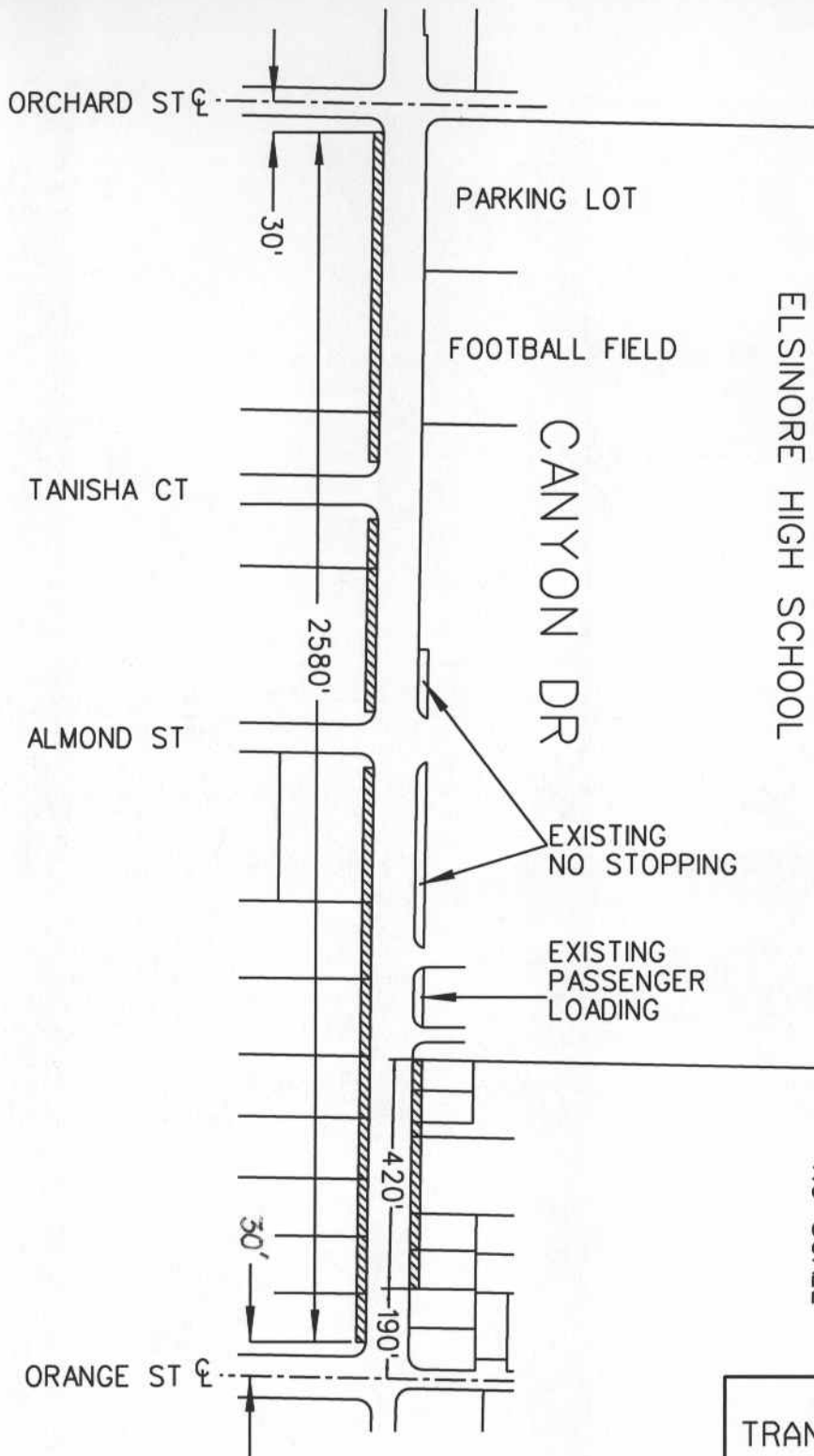
