SUBJECT: Ratify the First Amendment to the Agreement with Alternatives to Domestic Violence

BACKGROUND: (Continued).

Alternatives to Domestic Violence obtained a grant from the California Department of Health Services to fund the Community Intervention for Domestic Violence program; and selected the County of Riverside as a subcontractor to provide education and prevention services. On March 13, 2001, item 3.30, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved a two year agreement with Alternatives to Domestic Violence for the period March 13, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

The overall goal of this Agreement is to provide community intervention for domestic violence with emphasis on prevention and education. The two specific areas that are addressed are 1) Participate in the development of a Core team to provide awareness and education; and 2) Provide staff for the provision of domestic violence prevention education through presentations to high school students in targeted locations.

The California Department of Health Services has notified Alternatives to Domestic Violence of a two year extension of the grant. Alternatives to Domestic Violence wishes for the County of Riverside to continue to provide education and prevention services on domestic violence for the duration of the grant period.

FINANCIAL DATA: This Agreement has been extended through June 30, 2005 in the amount of \$22,080 annually. The additional funding of \$44,160 is for Fiscal Year 2003/2004 and Fiscal Year 2004/2005.
