**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement with Molina Healthcare of California

**BACKGROUND:** (Continued).

The County of Riverside Board of Supervisors first approved the agreement with Molina Healthcare of California on January 9, 2001, item 3.23. Then the agreement was renewed on March 5, 2002, item 3.7. Molina Healthcare of California is contracting with the County of Riverside Community Health Agency Department of Public Health, Nutrition Services Branch to provide nutrition and health education services and programs to Molina Healthcare members in Riverside County. Molina reimburses the County of Riverside for specific nutrition and health education services in the amount not to exceed \$30,000 annually.

One of the programs provided by the County of Riverside is the Child Safety Seat Education class that includes discussion about child safety seat laws and demonstrations of how to secure the child and the seat in the vehicle. Class participants receive a five point convertible car seat. Currently, this program is available to members who are pregnant or have an infant less than one year of age. This Amendment extends the car seat eligibility to Molina members up to 18 months of age.
