SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT RENEWAL GRANT AGREEMENT—ABC RECOVERY CENTER

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approves and:

1. Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Grant Agreement between Riverside County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for a Supportive Housing Program (SHP) Grant in the amount of \$48,414 for the period of December 1, 2003 through November 30, 2004.
2. Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to ratify and sign the attached Contract, HU 1545 00, between DPSS and ABC Recovery Center;
3. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to sign amendments to the Contract, not to exceed the maximum contract amount; and
4. Authorizes the Director of DPSS to administer the program with ABC Recovery Center.

SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT RENEWAL GRANT
AGREEMENT—ABC RECOVERY CENTER

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BACKGROUND:

Since 1996, the County of Riverside has submitted a consolidated application to HUD on behalf of homeless project sponsors that provide services for homeless persons in Riverside County. As a result of the 2002 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Consolidated Application from the County, HUD has approved the ABC Recovery Project for Transitional Housing for Chronic Substance Abusers, its Technical Submission, and has executed the Renewal Grant Agreement CA16B208005 for this project.

The Riverside County Continuum of Care Consortium's mission is to develop and maintain a seamless system to assist homeless persons and families in Riverside County in achieving self-sufficiency and finding affordable permanent housing. For those that are not able to achieve self-sufficiency due to illness, age, or infirmity, help them find appropriate care and affordable permanent housing to the extent that they are willing to accept assistance. The Continuum's approach provides a comprehensive foundation for a service delivery system that provides a balance of outreach, prevention, emergency, transitional, and permanent housing with necessary support service resources to move homeless persons and families into the mainstream of society. The Continuum is made up of all of the governmental, non-profit, faith based and private institutions providing housing, supportive services, outreach, and prevention services to the homeless within the County.

On June 18, 2002 (Agenda Item 3.69), your Honorable Board approved a motion to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included a renewal supportive housing program submitted by ABC Recovery Center. HUD has approved the application and has allocated \$48,414 for a 1-year period.

Subsequently, DPSS requests that the Board approves and signs the Sponsor Agreement between DPSS and ABC Recovery Center for the following:

Recipient Name	Agreement Term	Project and Type of Service	Amount
ABC Recovery Center	1-Year Renewal	<u>Transitional Housing Project.</u> Since December 1, 2000, the ABC Transitional Project has been operating and providing supportive services for chronic substance abusers. The previous Agreement Term ended on November 30, 2003. The attached renewal will extend the current services provided under the Project for an additional one (1) year.	\$48,414

HUD has indicated in its Grant Agreement that eligible costs incurred between the end of the final operating year under the original grant and the execution of this Renewal Grant Agreement may be paid with funds from the first operating year of this Renewal Grant.

FINANCIAL DATA: No County General Funds are required.

The budget for the two (2) fiscal years is broken down as follows: Year 1- \$24,207; and Year 2-\$24,207. The total agreement amount is \$48,414.
