Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents. Amend the Transportation Improvement Program's project budget as proposed on Attachment "A".

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated November 25, 2003 (agenda item 3.49) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of traffic signal, highway lighting and associated improvements at the intersection of State Route 74 and Palomar Road, including the construction of the permanent closure of the Ethanac Road connection to State Route 74, in the Romoland area of Riverside County.

RE: Construction of Traffic Signal, Lighting and Road Improvements at State Route 74 and Palomar Road, Romoland area

February 13, 2004

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Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 pm, Wednesday, January 7, 2004. Three bids were received. The lowest and best bid was submitted by R.J. Noble Company in the amount of \$327,912.00. The bid is \$20,187.00 (6.56%) more than the Engineer's Estimate. Bids exceeded the Engineer's Estimate due to low estimates for certain bid items. Review of the bids indicates that it is not likely that lower bids would be received should this project be re-bid. The contractor is qualified.

Annual traffic signal operating costs are estimated at \$2,500 for the County's funding share (1/2), to be funded from gas tax. Caltrans will fund 1/2 of the operating costs.
