SUBJECT: Public Hospital Outpatient Services Supplemental Reimbursement Program (AB-915) Agreement.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Authorize the Hospital Director to sign the agreement with the State Department of Health Services.

BACKGROUND: AB 915, (Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14105.96) enacted by the Legislature in August 2002, allows for federal supplemental payments for un-reimbursed Medi-Cal hospital outpatient fee-for-service (FFS) expenses based on certified public expenditures (CPE) incurred at public hospitals. Generally, an eligible hospital's un-reimbursed Medi-Cal FFS expenses will be considered Medicaid expenditures, which will be eligible for a federal match. Consequently, the hospital will receive reimbursement for the federal share, approximately 50 percent of the expenses, which will represent net new revenue to the hospital. This revenue is reflected in the County's current forecast.
