SUBJECT: Increases in Purchase Order Amounts for Geopacifica and BV Engineering for Geotechnical Engineering and Plan Check Professional Services

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors,

1. Approve the increase in the contract with Geopacifica (#TLARC-91842-001-008-06/03) from \$1,700,000 to \$2,200,000 for FY03/04, for a total contract amount of \$4,300,000 for the three (3) year period.
2. Approve the increase in the contract with BV Engineering (#TLARC-96109-002-008-06/03) from \$350,000 to \$500,000 for FY03/04, for a total contract amount of \$1,150,000 for the three (3) year period.
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute the Contract Change Request on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND:

Both of these vendors are in the final year of three (3) year contracts, which expire on June 30, 2004. Both of these vendors have been able to meet the quality and turnaround time required for building permit plan review while other current vendors under contract with the County are reducing their services to the County due to other business opportunities. As such it is necessary to increase the maximum amount of these two contracts to maintain the existing service level. The terms and prices of the purchase order agreements will remain the same as currently exist.

The grading and building permit fees and deposits by developers will be used to pay for all of the contractor's charges.
