RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Imperial Irrigation District (IID) and the Department of Public Social Services-Department of Community Action (DPSS-DCA) to fund the 2004 Emergency Energy Assistance Program (EEAP) extending the end of the term from December 31, 2003 to December 31, 2004;
- 2) Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to sign assurances, exhibits, and reports made under the Agreement; and
- 3) Authorize the Director of DPSS-DCA to administer the program.

BACKGROUND:

IID, a local utility company, provides the EEAP program which pays delinquent energy bill accounts of eligible IID customers. DPSS-DCA administers this program by determining the eligibility of low-income Coachella Valley IID customers per the IID criteria.

IID will allocate an allotment of \$10,000 to fund the EEAP. These funds would remain with IID to be applied to eligible delinquent IID utility accounts and would not be deposited with the Riverside County Auditor Controller's Office. Additionally, IID would compensate DPSS-DCA up to 8% of the funds pledged (\$800) for administrative services.

On June 3, 2003 (Agenda #3.23), the Board accepted the 2003 Program Year allocation. This Addendum to the MOU would establish the 2004 Program Year funding to continue these activities. Therefore, the Director of DPSS-DCA requests that the Board approves and authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Addendum extending the end of the term of the MOU from December 31, 2003 to December 31, 2004 and establishing the 2004 Program Year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds will be required. Sufficient funds have been allocated through the County budget process to cover the 8% estimated revenue.
