
These appropriations, if approved, will provide substantial economic benefits to the citizens of Riverside County.

SUPPORTING FEDERAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR FLOOD CONTROL PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005

WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives Committee on Appropriations, Sub-Committee on Energy and Water Development, and the United States Senate Committee on Appropriations, Sub-Committee on Energy and Water Development are holding hearings to consider appropriations for Flood Control and Reclamation Projects for Fiscal Year 2005 and have requested written testimony to be submitted to the committees prior to March 31, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District supports the continuation of construction efforts on a critical flood control project on Murrieta Creek; the furtherance of construction activities on the Santa Ana River Mainstem project, including Prado Dam; and the continuation of Corps efforts in developing a Special Area Management Plan for the San Jacinto and Santa Margarita River Watersheds; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular session assembled on March 9, 2004, that they support appropriations by Congress for Fiscal Year 2005 for the following projects:
