**BACKGROUND:** The agreements with Central County United Way, covering the period October 31, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the amount of \$14,515, continues the provision of the Senior Companion Program, to seniors of Moreno Valley, Perris, Murrieta, Temecula, Banning, Beaumont, Hemet and San Jacinto. The Senior Companion Program consists of providing low-income seniors opportunities to contribute their services in a community setting, to help other seniors maintain an independent living environment. This program provides a stipend and other benefits that enable seniors to participate without incurring personal costs.
