SUBJECT: Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee (MSRC) FY2001-2002 Diesel Particulate Trap Retrofit Program.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the attached Extension Agreement between the County of Riverside and MSRC for continued participation in the above referenced program.

BACKGROUND: On January 14, 2003, the Board of Supervisors approved a contract between the County and MSRC for grant funds to help offset the County's costs associated with the PM Trap retrofits approved by the Board in 2002. The program was granted a First Extension of Time for completion of the retrofits on the County's on-road heavy-duty diesel vehicles to August 2003. Unfortunately, the retrofits were delayed by the trap manufacturers' inability to meet the demand in Southern California. The MSRC Board has approved a Second Extension of Time for the 2001-2002 grant awarded to the County. The attached agreement will extend the program for an additional ten months from the date of execution.
