SUBJECT: Anza Park Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve a project construction budget of \$195,000.00;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the project; and
3. Authorize and direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids for the construction of the Anza Park Project.

BACKGROUND: On July 1, 2003 the Board of Supervisors approved using Third District Developer Agreement and EDA funds for the rehabilitation of Anza Park. The Board has also approved a contract with Holt Architects to complete construction plans for the renovation of this community park. Plans have been completed and the project is now ready for bidding. The project consists of the installation of new landscaping and irrigation, a new basketball court, a new tot lot, picnic areas with shade structures, tables and benches, outdoor band shell improvements, perimeter fencing, and monument signage for the park.

Contract specifications have been reviewed and approved by County Counsel. With Board approval a bid opening will be scheduled for April 7, 2004.
