SUBJECT: LANDOWNERS AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZATION TO BURN PROPERTY

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

- 1) That the Board of Supervisors approve the action and authorize the burn on behalf of the County of Riverside and Riverside County Fire/CDF.
- 2) That the six attached copies are executed on behalf of the action and returned to the Supervisors office for further processing.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) is currently in the process of road construction of State Highway 74. As a result of the road-widening project, several residential and business relocations have occurred, leaving structures vacant and ready for demolition. These vacant structures present an excellent opportunity for fire personnel to obtain rescue safety training including, a live burn, if weather, traffic and air quality standards permit.

RCTC supports the training of the public safety personnel and is providing the structures at no cost to the County.
