SUBJECT: Ratify the Second Amendment to Subcontract #DPH03K.013 between Palo Verde Unified School District and Community Health Agency.

BACKGROUND: (Continued).

The Regional Access Project (RAP) has contracted with Riverside County Community Health Agency for the implementation and operation of the Healthy Children Connection (HCC) Program in eastern Riverside County. This allocation is for second year funding.

Riverside County Community Health Agency Department of Public Health is collaborating with Palo Verde Unified School District and Catholic Charities to continue HCC services to the Palo Verde Valley. The program utilizes the promotora model which involves recruitment, training and utilization of community volunteers as peer health promoters to provide door-to-door outreach to families, promote early entry into prenatal care, and promote timely immunizations of young children. A Public Health Nurse will provide home visitation as part of case management activities.

The Scope of work (Exhibit A) has been modified to clarify service provision and use of volunteers. The Payment Provision (Exhibit B) had been also modified to reflect the Fiscal Year 2003/2004 budget.

JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY: The acceptance of the award from the Regional Access Project was delayed, thus the subcontract could not be routed earlier.

This Agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
