SUBJECT: Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Calimesa and the County allowing County Library property tax revenues to be transferred to the City to be used for library purposes.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the attached Memorandum of Understanding for Tax Revenues for Library Functions with the City of Calimesa.

BACKGROUND: In 2002, the portion of the City of Calimesa that was formerly part of the Beaumont Library District was annexed into the Riverside County Library System and property tax increment from that annexation was approved by the Board of Equalization to be distributed to the County Library fund. This agreement allows the County Library to transfer the property tax increment resulting from this annexation to the City for library purposes only. For FY 2002/2003 the amount is \$23,805.77 and the estimated amount for FY 2003/2004 is \$23,814.52. The City of Calimesa Library Commission, the County Librarian and Calimesa Library staff will work together to make appropriate use of these funds. The City of Calimesa is scheduled to approve this agreement at the City Council meeting on April 5, 2004.
