SUBJECT: Approval of the First Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the City of San Jacinto

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the first Amendment to the law enforcement services Agreement with the City of San Jacinto for the provision of a sworn employee to serve as the City's Police Chief, and authorize the Chairperson to execute the Amendment on behalf of the Board.

BACKGROUND: On October 28, 2003 (3.25), the Board approved an Agreement for the Sheriff's Department to provide a sworn employee, Captain or higher, to act as an interim Police Chief in the City of San Jacinto, while the city decided on the future direction of its municipal police force. The term of this Agreement expired on March 31, 2004.

On March 18, 2004, the San Jacinto City Council executed a separate Agreement with the County for the Sheriff's Department to provide the full range of law enforcement services for a five-year term. The Sheriff's Department has submitted this Agreement for Board review and approval on today's Agenda.

Both the City and the Sheriff's Department recommend that the Sheriff continue to supply a sworn employee to act as the City Police Chief, at least until the Sheriff's Department is scheduled to begin providing full service on June 1, 2004. Regardless, of the service start date, the proposed Amendment specifies an Agreement termination date of June 30, 2004.

The Amendment also specifies that the rank of the provided sworn employee may be "Lieutenant or higher". County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.
