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ORDINANCE NO. 831

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
ESTABLISHING ASSESSOR FEES FOR
UNDIVIDED INTERESTS AND SEPARATE VALUATIONS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. This Ordinance adopts and establishes fees authorized by law, in the amount reasonably necessary to recover the cost incurred by the County Assessor in providing the services enumerated herein.

Section 2. Authority. The authority for the fees established herein is found in the California Revenue and Taxation Code, Sections 2821, 2802 and 4151.

Section 3. Severability. Should any fee herein established be held to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining fee provision.

Section 4. Fees. The Assessor shall collect the following fees for the services or product rendered:

- (a) Undivided Interest \$90.00
- (b) Separate Valuations \$236.00

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of adoption.


