



BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinley Homeless Act of 1987 (Public Law 100-77), the City of Riverside has been awarded Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funds for the operation and maintenance of emergency shelter facilities. In accordance with program requirements, the City of Riverside would like to partner with DPSS and enter into a two-part agreement for the period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 according to the terms and conditions stated below.

• **MEN'S AND FAMILIES' SHELTERS**

The City of Riverside will provide DPSS the sum of \$68,970 in ESG funds and \$60,000 in Public Works funds. DPSS has contracted with the Institute for Urban Research and Development to operate and maintain a 50-bed emergency shelter for homeless men and a 50-bed emergency shelter for homeless families, both in the City of Riverside.

• **EMERGENCY COLD WEATHER SHELTER PROGRAM (ECWSP)**

The City of Riverside will provide DPSS the sum of \$45,980 in ESG funds to support the ECWSP program operating at the Riverside National Guard Armory. DPSS has contracted with the Path of Life Ministries to operate and maintain an emergency cold weather shelter at the Riverside National Guard Armory.

The effective date of July 1 is the City of Riverside's traditional start date for all funding agreements, which allows the County to charge any allowable expenses incurred since July 1, 2003.

The Board previously approved a similar City of Riverside ESG agreement on March 3, 2003 (#3.23) in the amount of \$118,750 for services provided at the Men's Shelter and the Emergency Cold Weather Shelter in Riverside.

FINANCIAL DATA:

Funds for operating the shelters have been included in the fiscal year 2003-04 budget.
