SUBJECT: Support for California Endowment Planning Grant for a Grandparents Raising Grandchildren One Stop Center

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Reaffirm support for the concept of a One Stop Service Center for Grandparent Raising Grandchildren.
2. Direct the key County Departments that serve this population (including Health, Social Services, and Mental Health) to actively support and participate in the planning process.

BACKGROUND: The Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Task Force, led by the Advisory Council on Aging and staffed by the Office on Aging, has been awarded a special project planning grant from the California Endowment Local opportunities Fund to engage in a strategic planning process for the deployment of a One Stop Center for Grandparent raising Grandchildren. Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County will receive the grant of \$49,700 and as a community based not-for-profit agency will act as the fiscal agent.

The Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Task Force, the Advisory Council on Aging, and the Board of Supervisors have all endorsed the concept of a One Stop Service Center for Grandparents. (Board Agenda April 8, 2003, Item #3.7 Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Task Force Grievance Report).
