Subject: Ratify the Third Amendment to Contract with the Research and Education Institute at Harbor UCLA

BACKGROUND: (Continued).

The California Emergency Medical Services – Statewide Evaluation of Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMS-C) project currently assists Riverside County with the evaluation of emergency medical services for children in an effort to better serve this population. The County of Riverside has developed a subcontract with the Research and Education Institute (REI) at UCLA to complete the majority of the project activities. The majority of the second year project activities include the need for more information about how the development, implementation, and sustainability of EMS-C components in EMS agencies in the State of California will be addressed. In order to ensure that all grant objectives are completed, the State of California has granted a three month, no cost, extension past the original September 30, 2003 termination date.

JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY: Notice of extension was not received from the State of California until early October. This Form 11 and attachments were subsequently submitted to County Counsel and through the County approval process.
