BACKGROUND:

SB163 (Chapter 795, Statutes of 1997), approved in 1997, was an amendment to the Aid to Families with Dependent Children - Foster Care program. The intent of this legislation is to authorize all interested Counties to provide children with service alternatives to group home care through the development of expanded family-based services. Programs are to include individualized or "wraparound" services in which services are wrapped around a child living with his or her birth parent, relative, adoptive parent, licensed or certified foster parent, or guardian. These wraparound services build on the strengths of each eligible child and family, and are to address their unique and changing needs.

Through a collaborative effort, Probation, Mental Health (DMH), Community Health Agency (CHA), Riverside Office of Education and DPSS developed a program for intensive Wraparound Services called the "Riverside County Wraparound Services Plan" that was approved by the State Department of Social Services in November 2002.

To implement this Plan, a MOU between DMH and DPSS was executed on April 2003. DMH will operate the program with Probation staff co-located with Mental Health as part of the wraparound team and will be responsible for State reporting. DPSS will be the lead fiscal agent responsible for State claims and maintain the SB163 trust fund.

Approval of this MOU will give DPSS the authorization to participate in the SB163 Wraparound Program.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Wraparound Trust Fund supplies funding for this program. No County funds are required.
