BACKGROUND:

Plans and environmental documentation are in progress to construct Newport Road between Menifee Road and SH 79. This segment of the Newport Road will provide a very important east-west arterial from I-215 to SH 79. To address the traffic circulation, safety and to support the development in the area to the north of Newport Road particularly between Olive Avenue and Salt Creek, all weather crossings are needed on Leon Road and Rice Road at Salt Creek.
