BACKGROUND: On April 6, 2004 the Board of Supervisors reactivated County Service Area No. 146 in the unincorporated areas of Lakeview, Nuevo, Homeland and Romoland. The CSA currently provides park and recreation and library services. Increased development within the CSA has created a need for additional services including a mechanism to maintain parks, trails, landscape parkways and open space areas. The additional services will also include streetlights and public safety services such as paramedic, firefighter and sheriff. Pursuant to Government Code 25210.31, the Board of Supervisors may add extended types of services within an established county service area if determined to be a public convenience and necessity. The adoption of Resolution No. 2004-222 will authorize CSA 146 to provide the aforementioned extended services.

3 AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION
4 OF EXTENDED SERVICES WITHIN

6 **WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 25210.4 and 25210.31(a) authorizes the County
7 to provide the extended governmental services within an established County Services Area; and

8 **WHEREAS**, it has been requested that the extended services of park maintenance, trail
9 maintenance, landscape maintenance, open space maintenance, street lights, and additional
10 sheriff, firefighter and paramedic services be added to CSA 146; and

11 **WHEREAS**, a public hearing was conducted by this board on May 11, 2004 after which
12 this Board determined that public convenience and necessity require that extended services
13 should be added to CSA 146.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
15 Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on May 11, 2004 that extended
16 services of park maintenance, trail maintenance, landscape maintenance, open space
17 maintenance, street lights, and additional sheriff, firefighter and paramedic services should be
18 added to CSA 146.

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that such extended services shall be provided locally
20 within the geographical boundaries of CSA 146, and that such payment for said extended
21 services shall be made from an assessment collected pursuant to Section 25210.77(a) of the
22 Government Code.
