1. Approve sole source purchase of ALERT Transmitters and Rain Gauge Top Sections from Hydrolynx Systems, Inc., NTE \$23,000.
2. Direct the purchasing agent to issue a purchase order on behalf of the District.

Departmental Concurrence

BACKGROUND:

The Flood Control District currently operates and maintains an existing network of Model 5096 Hydrolynx ALERT Transmitters located throughout the County. The new transmitters and top sections will replace other outdated ALERT equipment. Hydrolynx transmitters are required for system compatibility and reliability. Hydrolynx is the sole manufacturer and distributor of this equipment.

FINANCIAL:

Sufficient funding is available in the Internal Service fund for Hydrology fund 48000, for purchase of small tools and instruments.
