BACKGROUND:

In fiscal year 2002/2003, DPSS established a collaborative with RCC in an effort to better serve the CalWORKs population of Riverside County. RCC is an accessible comprehensive community college committed to providing affordable post-secondary education and vocational training including student and community services to a diverse student body. The district provides pre-college, tutorial and supplemental instruction for under-prepared students through partnerships with other educational institutions, businesses, industry, and community groups to enhance the quality of life and the harmony of the communities it serves.

RCC desires to provide DPSS with \$106,000 in funding to be used to provide RCC CalWORKs students with child care services. These funds will result in an average of 191 children per month receiving services. The Director of DPSS requests approval of MOU # CW 1598-00 with Riverside Community College District.
