**BACKGROUND:** Inland AIDS Project (IAP) has provided HIV Testing services since 1996. IAP has the facility and experience needed to provide the optimum provision of HIV testing services for the residents of Riverside County. Testing services through IAP increases safe and confidential access for individuals at risk for HIV Injection and allows for immediate referrals to care and treatment services.
