RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Agreement #CC0733-00 between Superior Courts of California, County of Riverside and the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to provide child care services for the term July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the amount of \$52,500;
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign any ministerial Amendments not to exceed \$52,500 annually and exercise renewal options for years 2, 3 and 4; and
- 3) Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

The Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) has had a contract with Superior Courts of California, County of Riverside to provide child care services at Riverside Juvenile Court and the Southwest Justice Center for children whose parents have scheduled court appearances at those facilities. These services provide an incentive for Child Protective Services clients to appear on their court dates, thereby reducing the number of out-of-home placements of children as a result of parents' failure to appear in court.

Since Superior Courts of California is not a county agency the contract requires Board approval. Therefore, the Director of DPSS requests the Board approve and sign this contract for child care services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: \$49,350 of this program's funds is fully reimbursable by the State. \$3,150 in County General Funds is included in the Department budget for FY 04/05.
