**BACKGROUND:** Funds provided under this Agreement support the provision of services, programs and other activities for senior citizens Countywide in accordance with Title III & VII of the Older Americans Act and The Older Californians Act. The services include Supportive Services and Senior Centers (IIIB) Congregate and Home Delivered Nutrition (IIIC & NSIP), Preventive Health and Medication Management (IIID), National Family Caregiver Support (IIIE), Long Term Care Ombudsman Services (VII-a), Elder Abuse Prevention (VII-b) and Block Grant funding for Community Based Service Programs (Brown Bag, Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Centers, Senior Companion, Linkages, and Respite Purchase of Service) as developed in our countywide strategic plan for aging services.
