9 **WHEREAS**, the hereinafter described portion of 60th Street was offered for dedication
10 for public road and utilities purposes by the map hereinafter-referred to, which offer of
11 dedication has not been previously accepted for public use by the County of Riverside,

13 **BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors
14 of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on _____
15 June 22 , 2004, that this Board accepts the offer of dedication and
16 recognizes that said road is a public road open for use by the general public:

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED**, that this
19 acceptance is for the purpose of vesting title in the County of Riverside on behalf of the public
20 for public road and utility uses, and is not an acceptance of the road into the County Maintained
21 Road System pursuant to Section 941 of the Streets and Highways Code and that said road will
22 not become part of the County Maintained Road System unless subsequently accepted into said
23 Maintained Road System by a resolution adopted by this Board.

25 Said road is in the County of Riverside, State of California, and is described as

4 That portion of 60th Street (Lewis Street) Lying Between Hudson Street and the easterly
5 boundary of Tract Map 7552, recorded in Map Book 90, Pages 7 through 9 inclusive, Official
6 Records of Riverside County, California and dedicated by map of Fairhaven Estates on file in
7 Book 6, Page 2, Official Records of San Bernardino County California, and a portion also
8 dedicated as Lot "A" on Parcel Map 7854 Recorded in Parcel Map Book 28, Page 73, Official
9 Records of Riverside County, California.

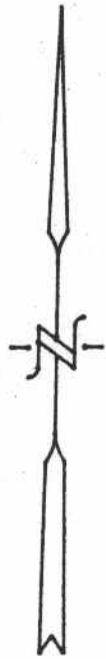
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11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Clerk of
