BACKGROUND:

On February 3, 2004, Synagro Inc. and the County of Riverside entered into a settlement agreement which contained in provisions for the payment by Synagro of "Host Fees" to the County of Riverside, and in section the potential for additional "Implementation Cost" fees to be paid by the Synagro to the County of Riverside. The establishment of the Temescal Valley Community Fund will allow these fees to be retained for future uses benefiting the Community as determined by the Board.

3 A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ESTABLISHING THE TEMESCAL VALLEY
4 COMMUNITY FUND

5 Whereas Synagro Technologies Inc. and Synagro Composting Company of California Inc.,
6 hereinafter collectively Synagro, own and operate a biosolids composting business adjacent to the
7 Temescal Valley community of Riverside, California, and

8 Whereas Synagro previously filed two lawsuits against the County of Riverside with regard to
9 the interpretation and implementation of permits as they relate to the operation of the facility, and

11 Whereas Synagro and the County of Riverside, on February 3, 2004, entered into a settlement
12 agreement (“AGREEMENT”) with regard to the lawsuits which contained in section 1.B. provisions for
13 the payment by Synagro of “Host Fees” to the County of Riverside, and in section 1.C. (2) the potential
14 for additional “Implementation Cost” fees to be paid by the Synagro to the County of Riverside, and

15 Whereas the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside agrees that there are numerous
16 current and potential projects and activities that can improve the quality of life for the Communities
17 within the Temescal Valley.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Temescal
20 Valley Community Fund is hereby established for the benefit of the residents near the facility, and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside elects
22 to deposit all of the Host and Implementation Cost fees remitted by Synagro, pursuant to the Agreement,
23 into the Temescal Valley Community Fund.
