**SUBJECT:** Construction of Concrete Sidewalk and Roadway Improvements on Opal Street, Pacific Avenue, Rustic Lane, Alton Street, 42nd Street and 45th Street, Rubidoux area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board accept the low bid of Sully-Miller Contracting Company of Anaheim, CA in the amount of \$1,492,000.00. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents. Amend the Transportation Improvement Program's project budget as proposed on Attachment "A".

**BACKGROUND:** By Minute Order dated May 25, 2004 (agenda item 3.32) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of concrete sidewalk and roadway improvements on Opal Street, Pacific Avenue, Rustic Lane, Alton Street, 42<sup>nd</sup> Street and 45<sup>th</sup> Street in the Rubidoux area of Riverside County. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 pm, Wednesday, June 9, 2004. Four bids were received.

The lowest and best bid was submitted by Sully-Miller Contracting Company in the amount of \$1,492,000.00. The bid is \$278,283.00 (22.9%) more than the Engineer's Estimate. Bids exceeded the engineer's estimate due to low estimates for certain bid items. Review of the bids indicates that it is not likely that lower bids would be received should this project be re-bid. The contractor is qualified.

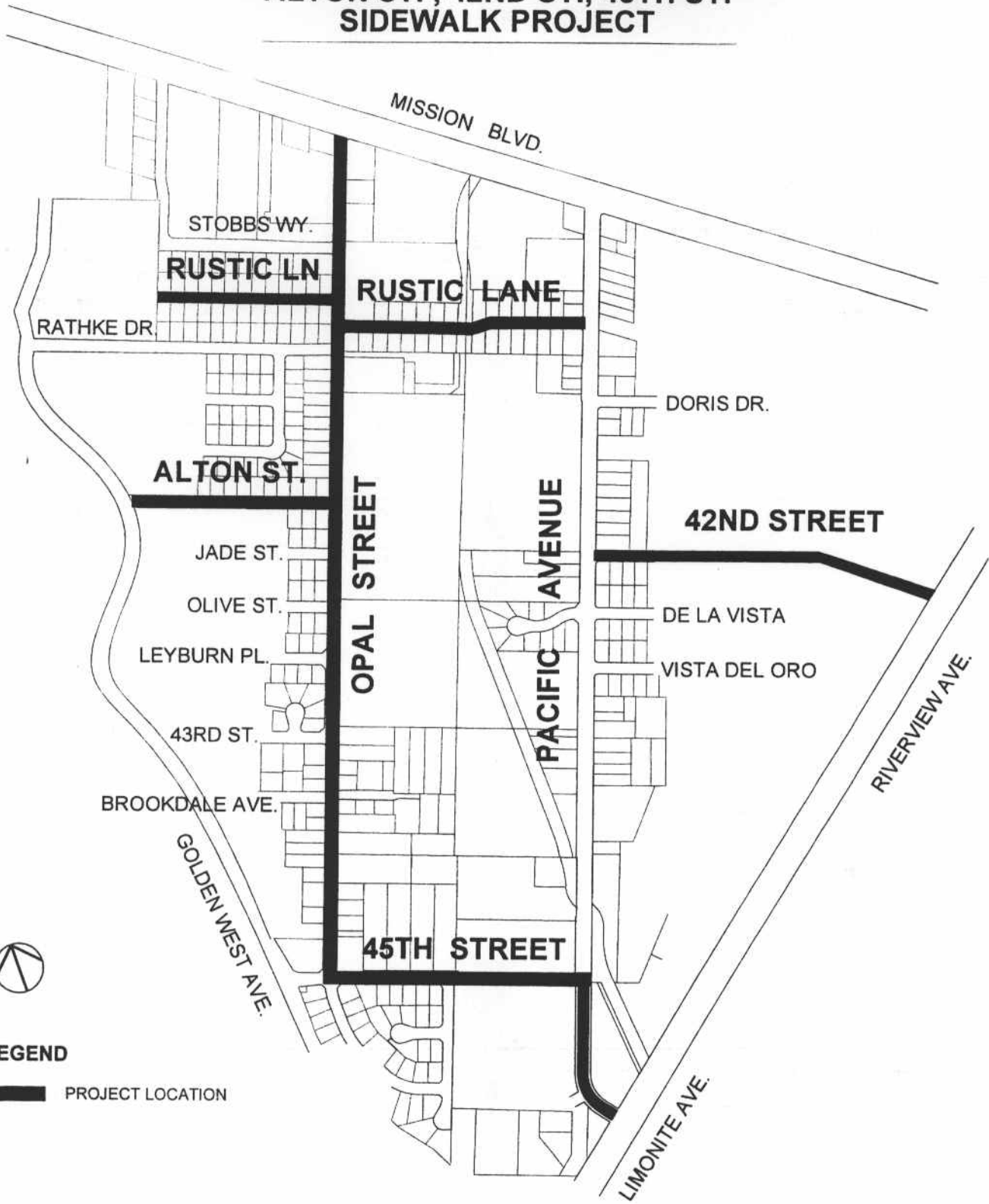
The installation of the sidewalk is being coordinated with the planned installation of street lights under a separate contract with the Southern California Edison Company. Street lighting installation costs are estimated at \$176,000, and annual maintenance costs for the planned lighting is estimated at \$10,000 to be funded by Lighting and Landscape Maintenance District No. 89-1-C, Zone 16.

An agreement with the Redevelopment Agency for construction funding of the project is submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution as a companion item to this submittal.
