SUBJECT: Crossing Guard Service Agreement - Alvord Unified; Corona-Norco Unified; Hemet Unified; Jurupa Unified; Romoland; and Val Verde Unified School Districts

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the cooperative agreements between the County of Riverside and the subject school districts regarding Adult School Crossing Guard Service within County of Riverside right-of-way and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute these agreements on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: The Board of Supervisors, on September 21, 1993, approved the phasing-out of County funds to the Adult School Crossing Guard Program. The Board also adopted, on December 21, 1993, a provision for the County to operate and administer the program with all costs paid by the school districts after July 1, 1995. This is a renewal of the Cooperative Agreements between the County and the above-named school districts for Adult School Crossing Guard Service for Fiscal Years 2004/2005 and 2005/2006.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

Based on the agreements, the school districts will pay for 100% of the costs for crossing guard services and the Transportation Department will administer the program.

The Adult School Crossing Guard Program budget is estimated to be \$449,222 for FY 2004/05 and is to be approved as part of the Transportation Department budget for Fiscal Years 2004/2005 and 2005/2006. Exhibit A shows the number of crossing guard posts in each of the six school districts.
