
SUBJECT: Mission Boulevard Streetscape Project – Phase 4



Background: On December 23, 2002, the Board of Supervisors made findings and approved the design contract between the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside and Krieger and Stewart Inc. for the Mission Boulevard Streetscape Project Phase 4. The project includes curb, gutter, sidewalk, block wall, wrought iron gates, landscape median, decorative parkway and street lighting between Riverview Drive and La Rue Street. The improvements will increase pedestrian and vehicular safety for the residents of the Rubidoux area.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the plans and specifications, authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids, delegate change order authority to the Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency and/or his designee in accordance with Board Policy B-11 and approve a preliminary project budget of \$2,000,000, so that the Redevelopment Agency may proceed with securing bids for the construction of the Mission Boulevard Streetscape Project Phase 4.
