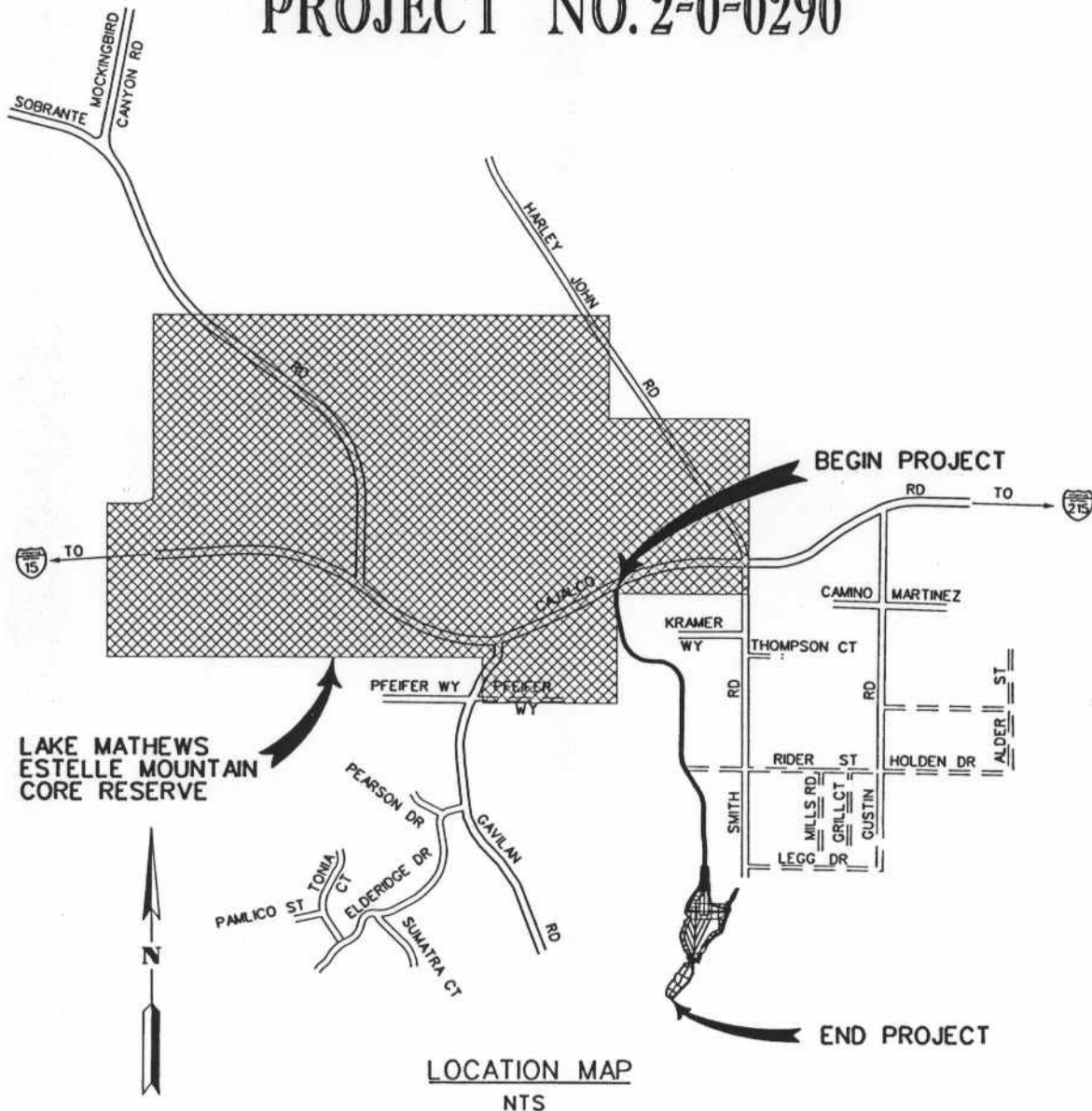

GAVILAN HILLS-SMITH ROAD CHANNEL & DEBRIS BASIN PROJECT NO. 2-0-0290



Gavilan Hills-Smith Road Channel & Debris Basin

This project consists of constructing approximately 3,600 feet of concrete lined rectangular channel and a debris basin at the upstream end. The channel begins at the existing double reinforced concrete box at Cajalco Road. Included in this project is extension of the existing Cajalco Road double box and a reinforced concrete box crossing at Rider Street. Also included is stream bed widening at the upstream of the debris basin per Department of Fish and Game requirement.
