At the VAC's regular May 4th meeting, the committee's district representatives considered the requests for renewal of Mr. Cullari, Mr. James, and Ms. Chandler, and voted to recommend that the Board of Supervisors reappoint these members to new 2-year at-large terms to expire on 6-30-06.

At the VAC's regular June 1st meeting, the committee's district representatives deliberated at length and decided not to recommend new 2-year terms for Mr. Matthews and Mr. Swann. The reasons given were infrequent attendance at VAC meetings and activities, and Mr. Swann's ill health. In notifying Mr. Swann of the committee's decision, I was instructed to invite his reapplication at such time as his health should improve.
