SUBJECT: Agreement with Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors

1. Re-designate Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County as the lead child abuse council for Riverside County;
2. Ratify and authorize the Chairman of the Board to approve and sign the attached Amendment #1 to Agreement #CH0524 between Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County and the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) for the period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005 in an amount not to exceed \$204,232 for FY03/04 and \$244,232 annually thereafter;
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments and exercise renewal options for years 2 and 3; and
4. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the program.

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with Welfare and Institution (W&I) Code Section 18969, the State Children's Trust Fund was established with the purpose of funding child abuse, neglect, prevention, and intervention programs. W&I Code 18970, encourages the development of local child abuse and neglect prevention and intervention programs, operated by private nonprofit organizations or public institutions of higher education with recognized expertise in fields related to child welfare. On August 14, 2001, (Agenda item #3.31) the Board designated the County of Riverside Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) as the public administrator of the combined Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment and Community Based Family Resource and Support Programs, and declared its intent to seek a qualified public or private non-profit organization to be designated as the lead child abuse council in Riverside County.

On January 8, 2002, (Agenda item #3.27) the Board approved and designated Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County (PCARC) as the lead child abuse council for Riverside County for the period of December 19, 2001 through June 30, 2003 with one renewal option that was exercised through June 30, 2004. This amendment revises the period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004. DPSS is requesting the Board re-designate PCARC as the lead child abuse council and approve the attached amendment to the initial agreement. Since some deliverables were scheduled in FY03/04 as well as FY04/05 it was necessary to make the effective date of the amendment July 1, 2003. In addition, there were small non-material changes that more accurately addressed the Welfare and Institutions Code sections for the entire period of the contract.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The funding for PCARC is provided from the Children's Trust Fund. Pursuant to State regulations, PCARC is required to provide a cash or in-kind match of 33 1/3% in addition to the funding allocated under this agreement. There is no additional cost to the county.
