SUBJECT: Fourth Amendment to the agreement between Foley & Lardner, LLP and Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the fourth amendment with Foley & Lardner, LLP and RCRMC for the performance period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005;
- 2) Authorize the Chairman to execute the amendment;
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one original and return two (2) original copies of the amendment to RCRMC - Contract Administration for further distribution and processing.

BACKGROUND: RCRMC has contracted with Foley & Lardner since November 2000 for legal counsel regarding Medi-Cal Contracting, Medi-Cal/Medicare payment issues and Licensing, Certification, Accreditation Matters. Legal issues to be addressed for this period include Medicare and Medi-Cal payments and funding issues, strategic planning in response to Medi-Cal and Medicare program change, Medicare and Medi-Cal compliance issues, licensing and certification issues, and health care litigation matters.
