SUBJECT: Resolution No. 413-557 for No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones on Wineville Road, Mira Loma area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution No. 413-557 for No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones on Wineville Road in the Mira Loma area as described in the attached resolution.

Also that the Board rescind Resolution No. 413-457 for no-stopping zones on Wineville Road.

BACKGROUND: Supervisor Tavaglione's office received a complaint regarding drag racing on Wineville Road.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review. Wineville Road currently has No-Stopping Any Time zones in effect. It was determined that, to facilitate enforcement by the Sheriff's Department and the California Highway Patrol, it would be appropriate to change the existing zones to No-Stopping / Tow-Away zones.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of these No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones.


The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

7 July 27, 2004, that pursuant to Ordinance No. 413, the following No-
8 Stopping/Tow-Away Zones are hereby established in the Mira Loma area:

10 On the east side of Wineville Road starting at a point 45 feet north of the
11 centerline of Riverside Drive to a point 2,125 feet north of said centerline, a
12 total distance of approximately 2,080 feet.

14 On the west side of Wineville Road starting at a point 60 feet south of the
15 centerline of Mission Boulevard to a point 2,225 feet south of said centerline, a
16 total distance of approximately 2,165 feet.

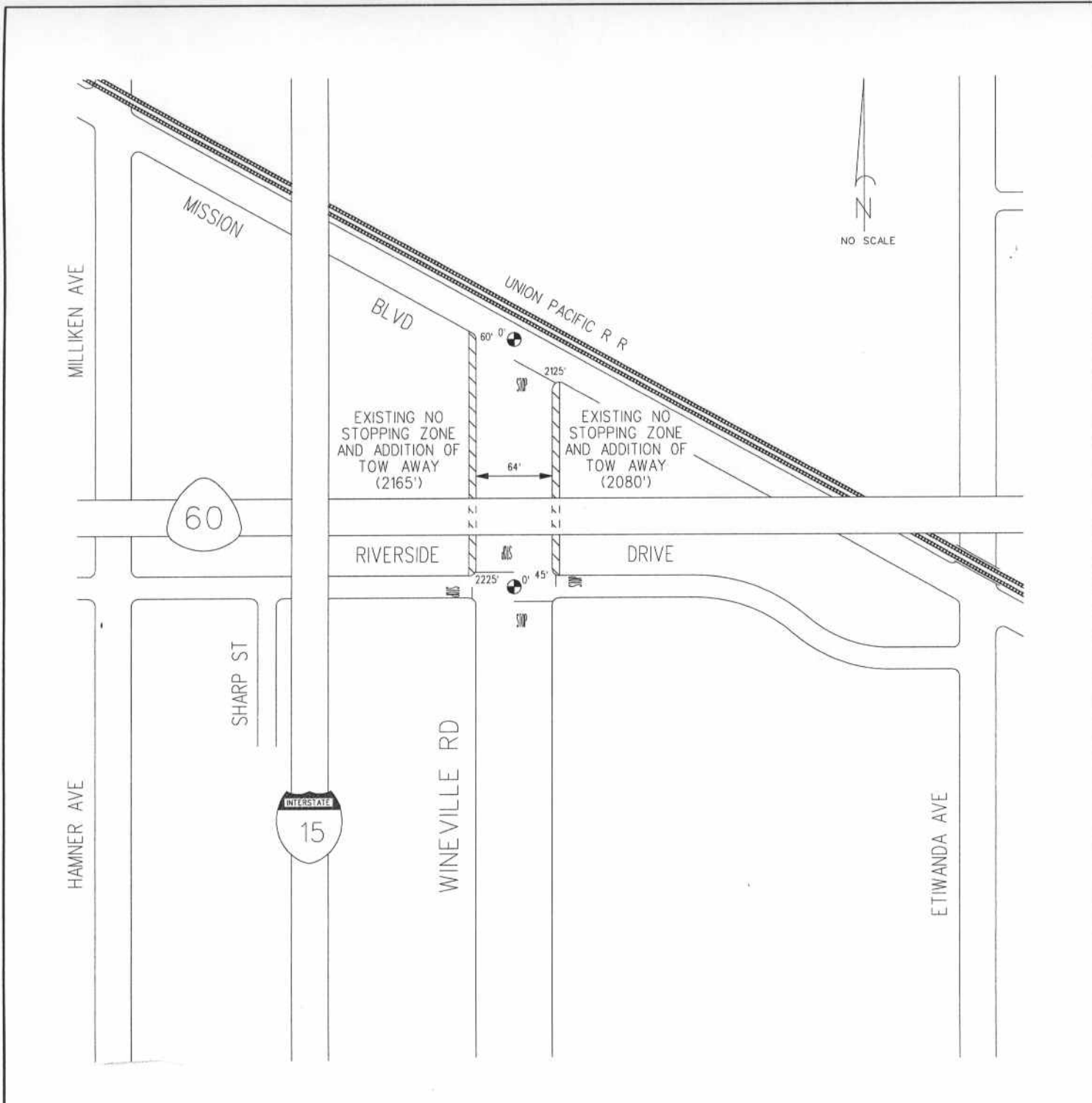

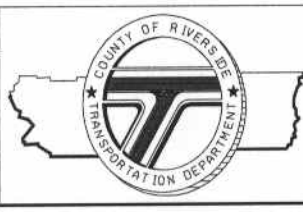
LEGEND:
