SUBJECT: Occupational Health and Wellness – Fifth Amendment to the Agreement with Individual provider Ronald Offenstein, Ph. D.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: 1) Approve the Fifth Amendment to the Agreement with the following provider and his effective date with Occupational Health and Wellness: Ronald Offenstein, Ph. D. effective July 1, 2004; 2) Amend all references to the period of performance from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 to July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005; 3) Establish a maximum amount of compensation of sixty thousand (\$60,000) dollars; and 4) Authorize the chairperson to sign three (3) copies of the agreement for each provider, retain one (1) copy and return two (2) copies of the executed Agreement to Human Resources for distribution.

BACKGROUND: Effective with the 2004-05 Fiscal Year, all outside services provided to the Occupational Health and Wellness unit have been reassigned from Community Health Agency to Human Resources. As part of that transfer, we propose to extend all known contracts with service providers for this unit for a one year period.
