BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated May 18, 2004 (agenda item 3.29) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the reconstruction and realignment of Gilman Springs Road, Phase II, between 0.8 Km and 3.1 Km NW of Route 79, and for the construction of interchange improvements at Route 79 & Gilman Springs Road, in the San Jacinto area of Riverside County. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 pm, Wednesday, June 16, 2004. Five bids were received. The lowest and best bid was submitted by Yeager-Skanska Inc. in the

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amount of \$2,392,139.44. The bid is \$145,498.64 (6.5%) more than the Engineer's Estimate.

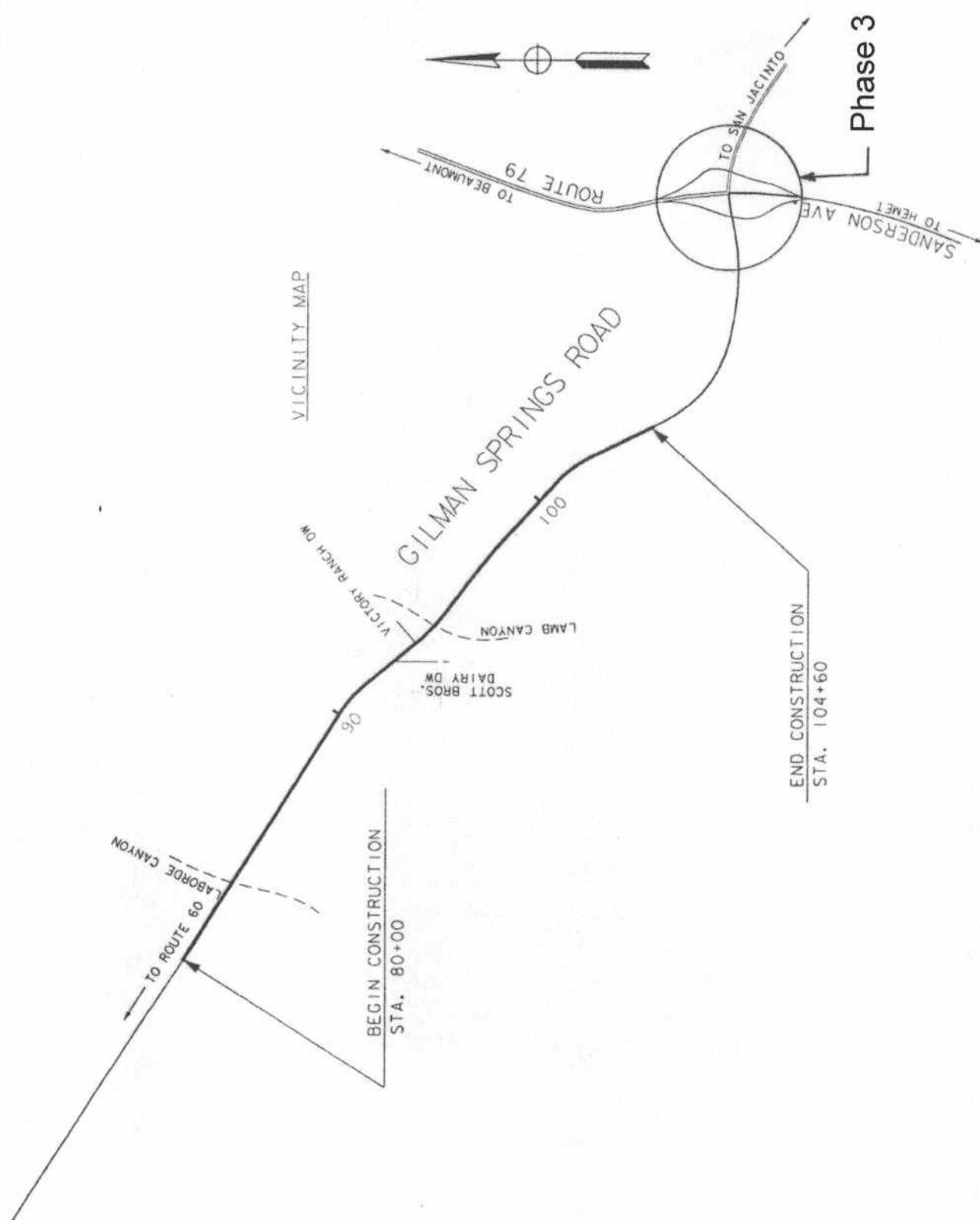
Bids exceeded the engineer's estimate due to higher than anticipated bid prices received for certain bid items, primarily concrete. Review of the bids indicates that it is not likely that lower bids would be received should this project be re-bid.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) is contributing \$100,000.00 towards the addition of right-turn lanes for Gilman Springs Road onto State Route 79.

Gilman Springs Road will be closed to through traffic for most of the construction period. Access will be maintained for local traffic.

The contractor is qualified.
