

SUBJECT: Resolution 2004-406 stating a position of opposition to the Initiative titled "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004."

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board join with me in adopting Resolution No. 2004-406 stating a position of opposition to the Initiative titled "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004."

BACKGROUND: On July 21, 2004 the Hemet City Council took a position (*Resolution No. 3833 - attached*) of opposition on a local Initiative that has qualified for the November 2, 2004 ballot. The Initiative is titled "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004." A report developed by the City indicates that this Initiative would have numerous negative impacts on the City and the Hemet Unified School District. The Initiative would also adversely affect portions of Riverside County, particularly the Hemet Ryan Airport. The City of Hemet has asked the County to also establish a position of opposition to this Initiative, therefore, I am asking the Board to join me in that action by adopting the attached Resolution 2004-406.

4 RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION OF THE KIRBY STREET TRAFFIC REDUCTION  
5 ACT OF 2004

6 **WHEREAS**, California Elections Code (CEC) Sections 9212 and 9214, permit  
7 cities to refer a proposed initiative to any of the City's departments for a report on the  
8 positive and negative impacts that the initiative may have on the community, and;

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to these sections the Hemet City Council did refer the  
10 "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004" (Initiative) to City staff for review, and;

11 **WHEREAS**, the detailed report prepared by City staff concluded that the  
12 proposed Initiative will have a negative fiscal impact on the City of Hemet in an annual  
13 amount of \$40,871.02 and on the Hemet Unified School District in an annual amount  
14 of \$2,187,000.00, and;

15 **WHEREAS**, the Initiative is internally inconsistent with the General Plan of the  
16 City of Hemet and creates a conflict with the County of Riverside's Hemet Ryan  
17 Airport Land Use Plan, and;

18 **WHEREAS**, the Initiative will result in a change of land use from  
19 commercial/industrial, as contemplated under the existing General Plan, to residential.  
20 The Initiative could result in the development of approximately 180 single-family  
21 homes.

22 **WHEREAS**, the Initiative is not required to meet the City's fair share of regional  
23 housing needs; the Initiative will have a negative impact on the City's jobs-to-housing  
24 ratio, and;

25 **WHEREAS**, the Initiative would result in a neutral impact on the funding of  
26 infrastructure, and;

27 **WHEREAS**, the Initiative may result in the loss of 1,328.6 potential jobs within  
28 the community, and;

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WHEREAS, the City Clerk certified the petition on June 22, 2004.

WHEREAS, the city departments delivered the report authorized under Election Code 9212 on July 21, 2004.

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2004, the City Council, adopted a Resolution ordering and calling an election for the initiative titled "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEMET, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, AND DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby state that the Council is opposed to the adoption "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004" initiative.

SECTION 2. That no public funds or resources shall be used in the campaign for or against the "Kirby Street Traffic Reduction Act of 2004" initiative.
