SUBJECT: Ratify of FY 2004-2005 Contract Agreement, with Accent Care for Supportive Services Program (Personal Care And Homemaker) covering all of Riverside County.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached renewal agreement with Accent Care.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: These agreements represent the last year of the four year 01-05 RFP contracting cycle.

The agreement with Accent Care, covering the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the reimbursable amount of \$153,518 for Homemaker & Personal Care to seniors of Riverside County. The Homemaker service provides light routine maintenance of a household, including such support as dusting, vacuuming, laundry, or meal preparation. Personal Care service will assist clients with routine care of a personal nature, such as bathing, dressing, personal appearance, feeding, and general hygiene.

SUBJECT: Ratify of FY 2004-2005 Contract Agreement, with Accent Care for Supportive Services Program (Personal Care And Homemaker) covering all of Riverside County.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

The Office of County Counsel has approved this agreement as to form.

This one year agreement with Accent Care replaces an agreement with Visiting Nurses Association of Inland Counties (VNA) after their announcement that they will no longer provide Supportive Services. Accent Care selection for this one year contract was the result of an RFP process. Approval of this agreement will prevent interruption of the services so vitally needed by this population.

These programs are funded by the Older Americans Act, Title III B, In-Home Services Program and supports the goals and objectives of the Office on Aging's four-year Strategic Plan, approved by both the Office on Aging Advisory Council and the Board of Supervisors.

Financial Impact: No additional County funds requested.
