**BACKGROUND:** (Continued).

Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is collaborating with Palo Verde Unified School District on the ongoing project, Healthy Children Connection, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. Palo Verde Unified School District offers services to clients in the Palo Verde Valley area of District 4 with funding through the Regional Access Project in the amount of \$92,143.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level.

The \$92,143 funding has been included in the Fiscal Year 2004/2005 budget which awaits approval by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.
