SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH

BACKGROUND:

On July 1, 2003, (Agenda Item #3.49), your Honorable Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included renewal funding for a supportive housing program operated by the Department of Mental Health. HUD approved the application and allocated \$231,468 for a 2-year period. The Department of Mental Health provides permanent housing for men with mental illness.

HUD approved the funding agreement on June 23, 2004. DPSS requests that the Board approves and signs the attached Grant Agreement between DPSS and HUD. The Director of DPSS will later enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Mental Health to run the Supportive Housing Program.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

No County General Funds are required.

The budget for the two (2) years is broken down as follows: Year 1 - \$164,302; and Year 2 - \$67,166. The total grant amount is \$231,468.
