SUBJECT: Acceptance of a Grant Award from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control and Adoption of Resolution No. 2004-373

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt Resolution #2004-373, which authorizes the Sheriff's participation in the Grant Assistance Program administered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).
2. Approve the grant Agreement, accepting funding in the amount of \$98,870, and authorize the Sheriff to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County.
3. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments on the attached Schedule A.

BACKGROUND: During FY 2001-02, in association with ABC, the Indio Station conducted a successful grant project to help combat alcohol related problems in the unincorporated areas of eastern Riverside County (7/31/01 3.36).

In FY 2004-05, ABC has awarded the Riverside County Sheriff's Indio Station \$98,870 to implement a project throughout the station's enforcement area. This project will utilize four Deputies and a Sergeant, specially trained by ABC Investigators, to carry out enforcement, education programs and prevention measures aimed at institutionalizing responsible alcohol selling and serving practices. County Counsel had approved the grant agreement as to form.

Objectives of the program include:

- 1) Conducting the Informed Merchants Preventing Alcohol-Related Crime Tendencies (I.M.P.A.C.T.) to identify and target area establishments that are selling alcohol to minors, already intoxicated individuals and to alcoholics.
- 2) Taking criminal, administrative or civil actions against establishments that continue to violate ABC regulations, cause community unrest, or generate crime.
- 3) Conducting Minor Decoy, Shoulder Tap or Cops in Shops operations, whereby officers use minors to attempt to illegally purchase alcohol, or ask adults if they will purchase alcohol for them.
- 4) Utilizing School Resource Officers to liaise with Domestic Violence organizations to implement Domestic Violence and Alcohol Awareness programs in schools.

At the project's conclusion, staff will produce a final report with an evaluation of the project's impact on calls for law enforcement service. More specifically, did calls for service decline at and around targeted establishments? Was there a diffusion of benefits to a wider area? Finally, did the community express an opinion that identified problems had improved?

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-373

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES PROJECT SPONSORED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside through the Board of Supervisors desires to undertake a certain project designated as Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Agencies to be funded in part with funds made available through the Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Agencies Project administered by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (hereinafter referred to as ABC):

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the SHERIFF of Riverside County is authorized, on behalf of the County of Riverside area served by the Indio Station to submit the attached agreement to ABC on behalf of the County. It is agreed that the Sheriff is authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the Board of Supervisors and to execute action on behalf of the County of Riverside for the program developed in the Indio Station service area and approved by ABC.

IT IS AGREED that the liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and ABC disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
